

Les songes Domaine Duffau 2013

Controlled place of origin : Gaillac

Grape : Braucol (50%), Syrah (30%), Merlot (20%)

Age of vines : 20 years

Soil : argilo-calcareous

Orientation : South and South-East

Yield : 35 hl/ha

Manual harvest



Thanks to a one year aging in oak barrel, this wine is well structured, round and with a long finish. The Syrah brings spicy aromas and richness, Merlot blackberry notes and roundness while Braucol features red fruits and in particular blackcurrent.

Serve at 18° with red meat or meat cooked in sauce or cheese.

Ageing potential: 15 years
