Songes is a specific French word meaning a kind of poetical day-dream. It reflects our state of mind when we embarked on this great adventure of creating our estate.

Thanks to a one year aging in French oak barrel and one year in tank, this wine is well structured, round with a long finish. The Syrah expresses spicy aromas and richness while Brauocol, a local type of grape, is scented with red fruits, in particular blackcurrant.

Serve at 18° with dishes cooked in sauce, red meat or cheese.

Ageing potential: 15 years
